

PRESS RELEASE NOTICE OF FLOOD

Thursday May 4th 2007

As a result of heavy rains and rapid snowmelt, the levels of the Coulonge and Outaouais rivers are continually rising and their banks are overflowing. The Municipal Council of Mansfield-et-Pontefract therefore initiated the emergency measures on the 3rd of May 2017 and calls on all citizens whose residence is located in a zone at risk of flooding to provide the means required to ensure the safety of their family members and the protection of their property.

Sand bags are available for those who need them at the municipal sand pit located at 32 chemin du Lac-de-la-Truite. We ask citizens to ensure that spaces at risk (basements) remain unoccupied during the night and, if necessary, to store the goods and furniture on the top floor. In addition, we ask you to ensure that dangerous products are stored in safe areas so that no propane tanks, oil tanks or the like can be washed away. We also ask any citizen who leaves his home to notify us and give us their contact details to reach them if necessary.
